PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

The Department of Immigration is pleased to roll out the Stamp-less Visa Regime with immediate effect as part of ongoing efforts to enhance service delivery through digital transformation.

Under this initiative, all visa services shall be processed through a fully digital and automated system. Applicants are no longer required to visit in person or produce their original passports at Immigration Offices for the following services:

1. Visa Extension
2. Re-entry Endorsement
3. Transfer of Visa from one passport to another

All applications must be submitted online through www.immi.gov.bt. Decisions, approvals, and related communications shall be conveyed electronically through the system. Digital approvals issued through the system shall constitute official authorization, and no physical visa stamp or manual endorsement shall be required to be affixed on passports.

Applicants are advised to ensure timely submission of applications and accuracy of information provided in the online system to facilitate prompt processing and compliance.

This measure reaffirms the Department's commitment to efficient, transparent, and citizen-centric service delivery in line with the Government's digital governance initiatives.
