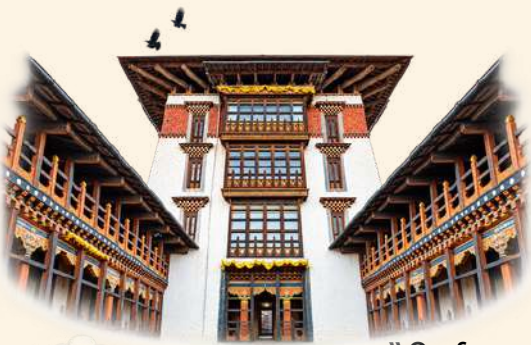

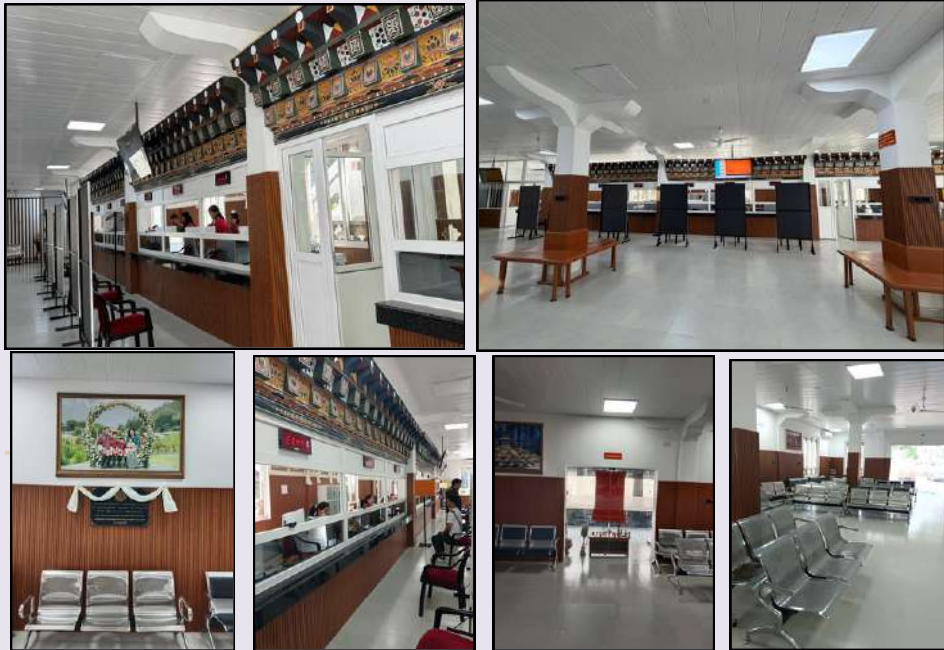

KNOW THE RULES: TRAVEL DOCUMENT

Always Carry Your Original Travel Document

A prior visa/permit approval does not replace the requirement to carry the original travel document.

- Indian nationals: Original Passport or Voter ID Card
- Other nationals: Original Passport

IMPORTANT

All travellers must carry the original, valid travel document and present it upon entry into Bhutan, regardless of whether the visa/permit was obtained in advance or issued on arrival.

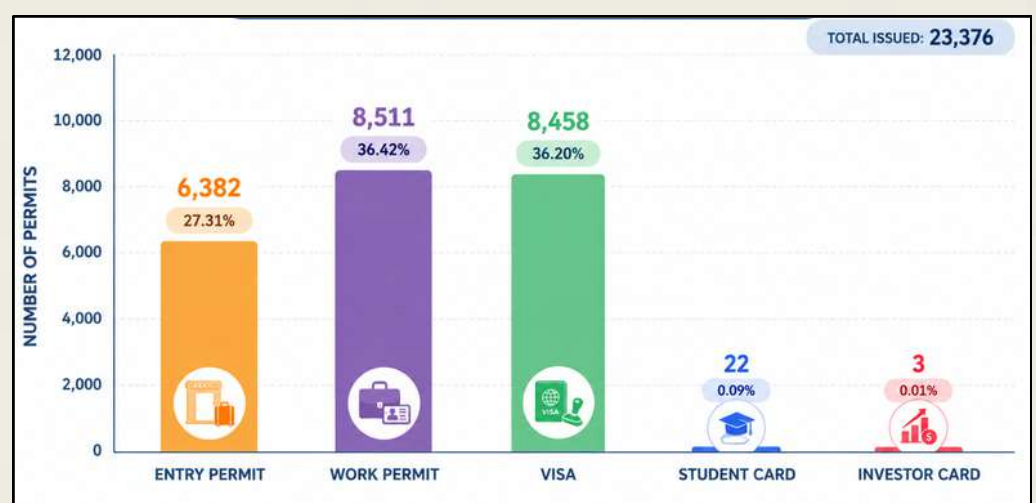
I. Revenue Collection: August 2026



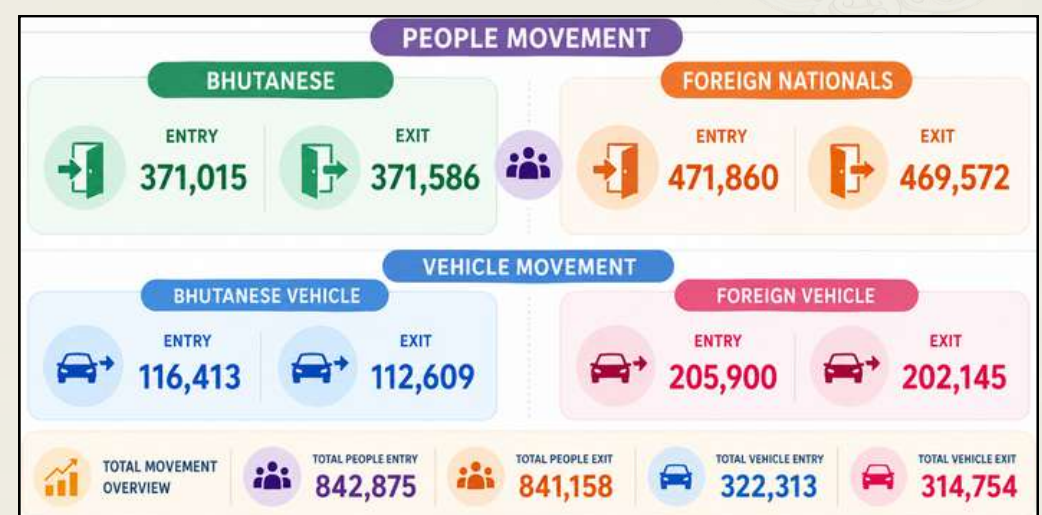
II. Comparison of Revenue Collection: April-August 2026
